Acid Aerosol spray cans – Not empty, still containing product Antifreeze Asbestos Batteries – Sort into separate plastic bags and label as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alkaline • Button • Lead Acid (Pb) & Gel Cell • Lithium (Li) • Mercury • Nickel/Cadmium (Ni-Cd) • SLA: car, lawnmower, motorcycle, sump pump • Zinc • Other Fertilizer Fluorescent CFL bulbs & tubes – Place each bulb in a sealed plastic bag, one bulb per bag. CFLs can also be recycled at Home Depot. Cooking oil recycled into bio-fuel!




